The Village of Rockton’s priority is to continually provide and maintain a safe drinking water source and distribution system for our residents. In order to accomplish this, the Village must perform required treatment, testing and maintenance of both the water and wastewater systems. After an in-depth study, the Village has concluded that the water and sanitary sewer systems will require major system upgrades. This will ensure the safety of public health and the environment in the future.

We understand that this comes as unwelcome news to residents of Rockton. Fuel, labor, equipment, testing and treatment fees have risen. Inflation has had a significant toll on operating costs and expenses. Beyond helping to alleviate these increased expenses, the funds will pay for the replacement of old water main and aging water lines. Funding will also be used to update and repair our sewer collection system to help prevent future backups and damage to residents’ homes, as well as the eventual construction of a new wastewater treatment facility.

These new rates go into effect on June 1, 2024. You will see these new rates reflected on your July bill.
