

Public Notice

Construction of new water main in the Wright and Kiles Blackhawk Acres Subdivision and Cannell's Corner Plats 1, 2, and 3 Subdivisions.

It is being financed by the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SRF).

With a wholly funded forgivable loan of \$1,294,086.28

The SRF program is administered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and receives a portion of its money to fund these types of projects from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. This project includes the installation of approximately 3,925 feet of new water main, new water services, water meters and private well abandonments.

Once complete, it will improve water quality for area residents and businesses in Rockton by connecting them to the Village water system, replacing their existing wells that are contaminated with high levels of PFOA, PFOS, and PFHXS.

SRF programs operate in each state to provide communities with resources necessary to build, maintain, and improve the infrastructure that protects one of our most valuable resources: WATER.
